

Due to the current situation, we have introduced the following additional site rules and changes in order to manage any risks effectively. We are following Government guidelines and PHE guidance on how to operate our site safely and wherever possible minimising risk to our players and staff. We ask that all players and visitors read the following information carefully, and adhere to these additional safety measures at all times when on site.

Additional Safe-Zone and General Site Rules

1. We are limiting the number of players during every game. Until further notice, we will not be accepting any walk-ons, so please ensure you have booked your place before arriving. You can make a booking online on our website. Once you have made your booking you will receive a confirmation email.
2. If you, or anyone in your household are exhibiting any of the following symptoms, or if you are currently self-isolating with your family, you must not attend the site: **Regular cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain or body aches.**
3. We reserve the right to refuse any person attending who appears unwell or is displaying any symptoms that, under government guidance, are linked to Covid-19.
4. For your own safety, if you are considered 'at risk' or have been advised to self-isolate or 'shield,' for any medical reasons, you must not attend the site, whether you are displaying symptoms of the illness or not.
5. Until further notice, Disclaimers and Registration Forms will not be provided on site. All forms are available on the website, and players are required to print and fill out the required forms before attending the site. Please bring the completed forms with you on the day, as players will not be able to book in and play without the required forms.

6. Please adhere to social distancing when you are parking / walking to and from the car park. To support social distancing, the onsite marshals will be allocating each player with a space in the safe zone when they arrive. Please follow all instructions given.
7. We have marked out dedicated entrances and exits to both the safe zone, and the gaming area. Please follow these directions to adhere to social distancing.
8. There are marked queue lanes which lead to the booking-in office. All players must adhere to these lanes to ensure social distancing.
9. Players will be required to adhere to social distancing during both the safety, and game briefings. This shall be monitored and upheld by our onsite marshals. We strongly advise that all players bring a face covering, (such as a mask or face guard,) to wear whilst out of game, and around the safe zone area.
10. We are currently unable to provide lunch or hot drinks. You are permitted to bring your own lunch and hot drinks if you require them. The site shop will remain open, and we will continue to sell snacks and cold drinks.
11. There is a hand sanitation station at the entrance to the safe zone. Players are required to sanitise their hands every time they enter the safe zone. Hand sanitiser will be provided.

Additional In-Game Rules

1. Where possible, all players must adhere to social distancing while in the game. We understand that this may prove difficult at times, but please do your best to comply. This will be monitored and upheld by our in game marshals.
2. Physical player contact is prohibited at all times.
3. First aid procedures have been updated to avoid physical contact. These will be explained as part of the morning game brief before each event begins.

The safety, health and wellbeing of our customers and staff are extremely important to us. We ask that everyone adheres to these rules while on site.

All our staff have received additional training in relation to Covid-19.
